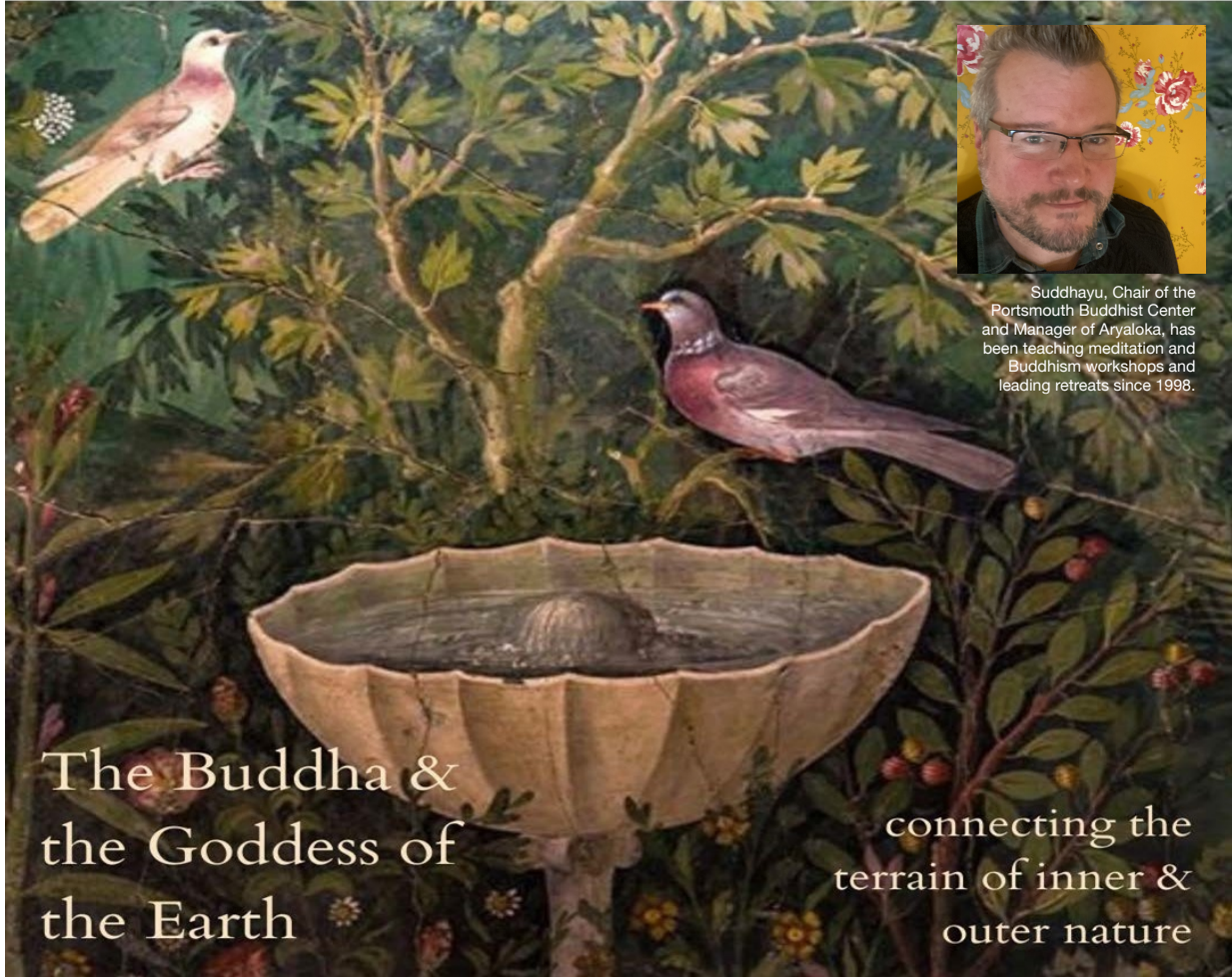


Camp Samish Residential Retreat 2024
